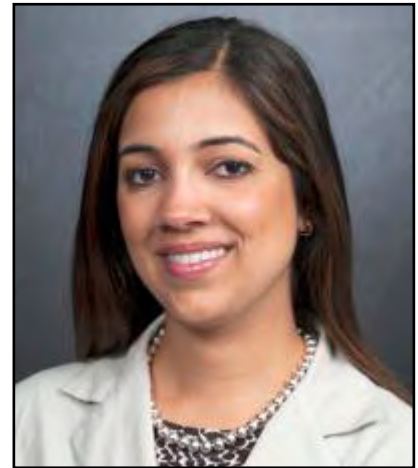

Monica Patadia, M.D.

Dr. Patadia is a graduate of Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine. She remained at Northwestern for her internship in general surgery and residency in otolaryngology-head and neck surgery. After residency, she completed an additional year fellowship in advanced rhinology, allergy and facial plastic surgery at the Midwest Sinus Center/ Rush University. Dr. Patadia is a recipient of an American Rhinologist Society CORE Grant for her work with "Mechanisms of B Cell Recruitment in Chronic Rhinosinusitis with Nalas Polyps." Her clinical interests include facial plastic surgery, including Botox injections, facial fillers, nose jobs, eyelid surgery, and face lifts. Other interests include nasal obstruction due to chronic rhinosinusitis, especially nasal polyposis and allergic fungal rhinosinusitis, allergic rhinitis and functional obstruction including nasal valve collapse. She is certified by the American Board of Otolaryngology and is a member of the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery, American Rhinologic Society, American Academy of Otolaryngic Allergy, and the Chicago Laryngologic and Otologic Society.

About the Program: Dr. Patadia has completed 10 years of rhinology at Loyola University Medical Center. This talk will focus on basic sinonasal anatomy followed by common sinus pathology and causes of nasal obstruction. The talk will include clinical case presentations involving the sinuses, with a focus on sinusitis of odontogenic origin.

Objectives for the Program: Attendees will learn the following:

- Basic sinonasal anatomy
- Common sinus pathology
- Medical and surgical management options of sinusitis, including sinusitis of odontogenic origin
