Shaun R. Young, D.D.S.

Dr. Young completed his undergraduate studies at the University of Florida in Gainesville and continued to earn his Doctor of Dental Medicine Degree at the same institution. There, he was a student-athlete and played on the Men's Tennis Team and served as the Dental school class president. Dr. Young completed his Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Residency at Emory University where he served as the Administrative Chief Resident.

Dr. Young's surgical expertise includes dentoalveolar surgery, implants, and bone grafting, orthognathic surgery, maxillofacial trauma and reconstruction, and temporomandibular joint surgery. He is a part of a successful private practice serving patients surrounding Tampa areas and holds privileges at Regional Medical Center Bayonet Point, Morton Plant Northbay Hospital, Mease Countryside Hospital, and Mease Dunedin Hospital.

About the Program: As the field of OMS continues to evolve over time, it is crucial to continue to elevate techniques and methods to ensure successful outcomes. Grafting and implant solutions have expanded rapidly in everyday practice, and OMS professionals are relied upon for significant ridge augmentation cases. The purpose of this presentation is to review patient and grafting considerations when addressing challenges associated with moderate to severe atrophy of the alveolar ridge. Dr. Young will explore customization in treatment planning, applying ridge augmentation techniques, as well as surgical steps and skills required to repeatedly produce successful outcomes for implant patients.

Objectives for the Program: Attendees will learn the following:

- Understand the biological foundations and clinical challenges associated with alveolar ridge resorption during grafting procedures.
- Explore the decision-making process, methods, and outcomes of different grafting materials to restore the alveolar ridge in patients with moderate to severe atrophy.
- Identify considerations for timing of staged procedures in achieving adequate ridge height and width for future implant placement.
- Analyze the impact of soft tissue grafting on esthetics, function, and long-term implant stability.


